WIFI setting and reset password

Step 1: Open the browser and enter "192.168.0.1"



Step 3: After logged in, the system is requested to change User Name and Password



Step 2: Enter "cisco 1" for User name and Password of below webpage.



Step 4: You can click "Setup>Quick Setup" to reset the related setting including change SSID of wireless network and Passphrase (password), setting Security Mode (suggest to apply WPA or WPA2-Personal).



Step 5: Press "Save Settings" to complete the setting.

FAQ

Question 1: How do you disconnect the wireless network?

Answer 1: Press the "ON/OFF" button at the front of Home WIFI modem. The wireless signal will be changed while press the button. The wireless network of Home WIFI modem is disconnected if the light is turned off.

Question 2: Does it need to restart the wireless network if log in "192.168.01" and press "Setup" to disconnect the wireless network? Can I press the "ON/OFF" button of Home WIFI modem?

Answer 2: It does not need to restart. The ON/OFF button can be pressed to restart the network.

Question 3: It has already installed wireless router (b/g/n/ac). Is it allowed to connect this WIFI modem together?

Answer 3: Yes, but it is suggested to use this WIFI modem for Internet and Wireless. If you want to use the original WIFI router together with this WIFI modem at the same time, you have to change the IP address of WIFI router.

Question 4: I am now using i-CABLE 10M/ 50M/ 130M services, is there any difference if the Home WIFI modem is upgraded?

Answer 4: Home WIFI modem is embedded wireless router. Wireless Network can be used.

Question 5: I am using broadband service by other operator. Is there any difference of installation and Network service?

Answer 5: The wireless router, can provide wireless network service, is embedded in Home WIFI modem. The computer have to set "DHCP" to obtain the IP address.

Question 6: If several equipments are connected, is it affected operation of the computer and other equipment?

Answer 6: It is the same as home router.

Question 7: Is there any specific computer equipment for Home WIFI modem?

Answer 7: Networking Hardware

Wireless equipment: To comply with 802.11b/g/n standard

Wired equipment (To comply with FE/ GE setting): Built-in 1000 Base-T LAN card (for 130M network service) or 100/ 1000 Base-T LAN card (for 50M network service).

Computer Hardware:

CPU: Pentium 200MHz or above

Flash Memory: 64MB RAM or above

Available disk space:100MB or above
